ESTABLISHMENT OF A PANEL OF SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR HIRING OF PLANT AND EQUIPMENT OVER A THREE YEAR PERIOD

Bidders are hereby notified that the bid documents for the above-mentioned bid were destroyed by the recent floods that occurred in our Province, therefore the Municipality does not have the necessary supporting documents required to continue with the awarding of this project. It is on this basis that the Municipality issues a notice of cancellation of the bidding process for this project which closed on 23 March 2022. Fresh/new bids are invited from the ESTABLISHMENT OF A PANEL OF SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR HIRING OF PLANT AND EQUIPMENT OVER A THREE YEAR PERIOD.

Bid Specification Documents will be available from **Wednesday, 18 May 2022** until the close of business on **Wednesday, 25 May 2022 at 15:00** from the offices of the Cashier at Ilembe District Municipality, Ilembe House, 59/61 Mahatma Gandhi Street, KwaDukuza, upon payment of a **non-refundable cash** deposit of R500. Bid documents will **NOT** be available at the briefing meeting.

A **COMPULSORY briefing meeting** will be held at **11H00** on **Thursday, 26 May 2022**. Prospective Bidders shall meet at iLembe Auditorium, 12 Haysom Road, KwaDukuza. Prospective bidders are required to bring their copies of the bid specification documents to the briefing meeting for signing.

Failure to obtain a Bid Specification Document or non-attendance of the briefing meeting will result in the immediate disqualification of your bid. Bids may only be submitted on the bid specification documentation provided by the Municipality.

All bidders must submit a Tax Clearance Certificate, or South African Revenue Services (SARS) UNIQUE PIN to enable the municipality to verify the bidder's tax compliance status online via E-filing. Any bid that does not comply with the bid conditions will be disqualified and will not be considered. Ilembe District Municipality Reserves its Right to Verify the Validity of the submitted Tax Clearance Certificates in terms of Section 256 (5) of the Tax Administration Act no.28 of 2011 and will apply MFMA circular 43 and Section 38 of the iLembe District Municipality's SCM Policy where necessary. Bidders must provide copies of audited annual financial statements (AFS) for the most recent past three years for companies that are required by law to prepare annual financial statements for auditing. All bidders must be registered on the National Treasury Central Suppliers Database (CSD) and must submit proof of registration.

Sealed bid endorsed "**Invitation to Bid No. TS/224/2021, ESTABLISHMENT OF A PANEL OF SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR HIRING OF PLANT AND EQUIPMENT OVER A THREE YEAR PERIOD**" must be submitted into the Bid Box situated at the **Ground Floor of ILEMBE TECHNICAL SERVICES BUILDING, 12 Haysom Road, KWA DUKUZA** by no later than **12H00 on Monday, 20 June 2022** where they will be opened in public. The name and address of the bidder must be clearly written on the envelope containing the bid. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days, from the closing date.

Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of iLembe District Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy in two stages and in terms of the 2017 Preferential Procurement Regulations. First stage of evaluation is functionality and the second stage being the 80/20 preference point scoring system. Only bidders who score the required minimum threshold on functionality criteria will qualify for the second stage of evaluation. This bid will be evaluated in terms of the 2017 Preferential Procurement Regulations pertaining to the PPPFA (No. 5 of 2000).

Ilembe District Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any of the bids and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of the bid.
